"No answer" includes web respondents who do not answer the question as well as telephone respondents who refuse to answer or who say they don't know how to answer. In cases where "not sure" was offered as an explicit option to web and telephone respondents, the "no answer" category includes only web skips and telephone refusals.

This survey was conducted primarily online, with some interviews conducted by live telephone. This topline shows the programming language for online administration. For details on how questions were slightly modified for phone administration, visit the questionnaire.

A NOTE ABOUT THE SAMPLE:

This survey includes a nationally representative sample of U.S. adults who are gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender or queer. In this topline, findings based on gay, lesbian or bisexual adults exclude those who are transgender. Findings based on transgender adults include those of any sexual orientation. Queer adults are included in the total and in the gay, lesbian, bisexual or trans totals if they indicated they also identify with any of these terms. There aren't enough adults in the sample who are queer but *not* gay, lesbian, bisexual or transgender to report on that group separately.

In this topline, DOV_MARITAL is coded 1 for respondents who are married and 2 for those who are living with a partner. Questions that were asked of people who are married, living with a partner or in a committed relationship were asked only of those who are in a relationship with one person or who have more than one partner but think of one of them as their primary partner.

"ASK ALL" or "DISPLAY TO ALL" used from here onwards in this topline refer to all LGBTQ adults.
