Methodological notes:

- Not all questions included in the Spring 2024 Global Attitudes Survey are presented in this Topline. Omitted questions have either been previously released or will be released in future reports.
- Survey results are based on national samples. For further details on sample designs, refer to the “About this research” section and our [international survey methods database](#).
- The data for the United States comes from Pew Research Center’s 2023-24 Religious Landscape Study (RLS), which surveyed 36,908 adults. For information about the U.S. data, including full question wording and details on how the open-ended responses were coded, please refer to the [RLS report](#) and [Topline](#).

Outside of the U.S., 35 countries were surveyed in the Spring 2024 Global Attitudes Survey. This Topline only includes results for the 28 countries (including the U.S.) where response options to questions about current and childhood religious identity could be coded at the detailed level of “Catholic,” “Protestant” or “Orthodox,” rather than just “Christian.” Consult the [Topline](#) from our report on religious switching around the world for additional results on religious identity.

Respondents were first asked about their current religious identity. In countries using phone or face-to-face interviews, unless otherwise specified, the response options were read aloud. Afterward, respondents were asked about their childhood religious identity; those response options were not read aloud, unless the respondent needed to hear the answer options again. Response options were tailored to each country and were identical for current and childhood religion. **In every country other than Australia and the U.S.:**

- If a respondent said their *current religion* was “Something else,” they were asked a follow-up question: “What religion is it?” The interviewer then recorded their response.
- We recoded these open-ended responses for current religion if at least 10 responses in a country (about 1% of the total sample in most countries) could be coded into one of the following categories: Buddhist, Christian, Hindu, Jewish, Muslim or religiously unaffiliated. Additionally, any of these recoded open-ended responses that could also be coded specifically as Catholic, Orthodox or Protestant were coded as such. All open-ended responses that were not recoded remained in the “Other religions” category.
- Respondents were not asked to specify what their childhood religion was if they said “Something else” for that question, so only closed-ended responses were used to determine childhood religion.

**In Australia**, both web surveys and telephone interviews were used. Coding was completed as follows:

- All **web respondents** who selected “Something else” for current or childhood religion were asked directly on screen to “please specify.”
- All **phone respondents** who said their current or childhood religion was “Something else” were asked a follow-up question by the interviewer: “What religion is it?” The interviewer then recorded their response.
- We recoded these open-ended responses for current and childhood religion into one of the following categories: Buddhist, Christian, Hindu, Jewish, Muslim or religiously unaffiliated. Additionally, any of these open-ended responses that could also be coded specifically as Catholic, Orthodox or Protestant were coded as such. All open-ended responses that were not recoded remained in the “Other religions” category.

Throughout this Topline, percentages are rounded to the nearest integer – including rounding down to 0%. However, survey-based estimates of 0% do not necessarily mean there are no people in those countries who identify with that religious group or were raised in that religious group.
