

TOPLINE SURVEY RESULTS

The study was conducted for the Pew Hispanic Center and the Pew Forum on Religion & Public Life via telephone by ICR, an independent research company. Interviews were conducted from Aug. 10 – Oct. 4, 2006, among a nationally representative sample of 4,016 Latino respondents age 18 and older.
